



ELIGIBILTY CRITERIA

A SAMARTH Fellow must be a young graduate or final-year student, or a young professional aged 27 or younger, aspiring to work in the social development sector. They should be passionate learners, ready to develop skills and engage in self-development tasks.

Why should anyone join the Samarth Fellowship?

The young individuals who sense intrinsic dissatisfaction with how communitylevel issues are perceived, and feel compelled from the heart to contribute their skills, time, and energy toward seeking better possibilities, are encouraged to apply here.

Who are eligible to apply for the SAMARTH fellowship program?

Any Indian youth who meets the below criteria can apply to this Fellowship:

- Must be passionate about working in the social development sector.
- Must be an Indian citizen aged 27 years or younger.
- Must have completed graduation in any field or be in the final year of their course.

What is the duration of the fellowship?

SAMARTH Fellowship is a nine-month program including orientation, two semesters, mid-point, and endpoint processes.
